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POL015-2 Safety Drills

The Boys & Girls Clubs of Mid Central Coast (BGCMCC) conducts emergency drills on a regularly scheduled basis to ensure the safety of all members, volunteers and staff. All members and staff shall be trained on the proper procedures for each drill type according to the BGCMCC Emergency Operation Plan (EOP). Following each drill, staff reviews what went well, what areas need improvement and discuss ways to improve. When necessary, procedures are updated and members are retrained. Emergency responders are not required to observe security drills, however, BGCMCC annually provides them with a notification at least 72 hours prior to holding drills and invite a representative to attend and observe the drill. The BGCMCC drill schedule meets all local and state requirements. Our school-based Club Directors will coordinate schedules and ensure consistent terms and language are being used with their local school district. The Area Director or designee is responsible for scheduling all required Safety Drills.

Parent consent is notated via a signed BGCMCC Parent Agreement.
